- suspension of loan repayments for three months
- allowing early term deposit redemptions without penalty
- assistance with insurance claim processing
- priority assistance in relation to any deposit or loan processing
- specially discounted loan rates to assist with bushfire recovery

Transport Mutual Credit Union Chief Executive Mr John Kavalieros said: "Once again we are saddened by the bushfire events unfolding across New South Wales. As a community-based financial institution, our affected members can be assured that we will assist them in any way we can".
